EGYPT AND ASSYRIA

THE HEBREWS SPEND 400 YEARS IN SLAVERY IN EGYPT

God calls Moses to rescue the Hebrews (the Burning Bush) and sends 10 plagues.

The Exodus – the Hebrews celebrate the first Passover and cross the Red Sea.

· While the Hebrews travel through the desert, God feeds them with manna.

- God makes a covenant with the Hebrews.
- In c.1250, the Hebrews move into Canaan.
- They are ruled by 12 Judges (1 woman, 11 men).
- Ruth moves from Moab to Israel and marries Boaz.
- The prophet Samuel guides the Hebrews, before the first kings, Saul and David.

God makes a covenant with David.

The Ark of the Covenant is moved to Jerusalem.

Solomon becomes King and builds the first temple.

- In about 930, the kingdom splits into two: Israel (north) and Judah (south); both are dominated by neighbouring lands.
  - Israel is conquered by the Assyrians.
