Ezra and Nehemiah return to Jerusalem and rebuild the walls.

In 332, Jerusalem surrenders to Alexander the Great.

Israel is ruled by his successors for 165 years.

In 167, the Maccabee brothers lead a revolt and restore Jewish rule.

However, by 63, Israel is under Roman control.
